Thrapston Charter Fair will be situated in Thrapston High Street, Oundle Road and Huntingdon Road. and will run from 2.00 - 6.00pm.

Each pitch is 3 metres x 3 metres and will be clearly marked on the pavement. Pitches will be allocated by the Charter Fair Committee.

Food vendors will be in Oundle Road where the size of pitch may vary.

Stallholders should provide their own tables, chairs and gazebo as required. Please note that you need to bring weights to secure your gazebo as it will be pitched on tarmac. Please avoid tying your gazebo to any bollards, lampposts etc in the street.

We recommend you have a sturdy shelter as good weather cannot be relied upon and the Charter Fair will not be cancelled due to inclement weather.

We are not in a position to provide electricity to the stalls.

Stall holder fees per pitch:-

Food and drink vendors - £120

Small business and craft stalls - £60

Charity and Community groups -£25

Retail business in Thrapston - £10*

*This will secure the space outside your premises on the High Street. Please get in touch if your premises is not situated on Thrapston High Street.

Entry to the Fair on the day will be via Chancery Lane.

You will be given a black sack when you sign in. Please take your rubbish home with you and ensure your pitch is clear when you leave.

Please ensure you only bring one vehicle into the High Street. All stall holder's vehicles must leave the area covered by the Fair by 1.30pm and be parked in designated areas until the end of the Charter Fair.

All stall holders will be allocated parking when they sign in.

Vehicles will be allowed back in from 6.00pm to take down stalls.

The roads will reopen at 7.00pm

Toilets are available in Sackville Street, Thrapston Plaza, Thrapston Co-op and St James Church Hall.

There are several cafes and coffee shops in and around the High Street for refreshments if required.

Please do not bring, attempt to sell or offer as prizes any aerosol- powered 'silly string' or live animals (including fish), Ball Bearing Guns, Laser Pens, offensive weapons and E-Cigarettes. Failure to adhere to this rule will result in the immediate closure of your stall and a ban from future events.

By submitting the completed and signed booking form with payment and all relevant forms you have will have reserved your stall for this year's Charter Fair. You will receive confirmation of your booking by email by return.

Further information for stall holders containing pitch details and arrival time will be sent out to the email address provided at the beginning of June 2026.

If you are applying for a TENS please contact us for a pitch number before making your application to North Northamptonshire Council.

The closing date for stall applications will be Friday 5th June and early application is advised.
