Charity stalls - £10.00 (proof of charitable status must be provided along with application)

Local Groups stalls - £10.00 (Thrapston, Islip, Titchmarsh)

Craft stalls - £25.00

Food & Drink stalls - £60.00 (copy of Food Hygiene certificate and/or Tens Licence to be emailed)

By submitting this booking form and payment is received along with copies of your Insurance, Hygiene Certificate (if applicable) and Charity Registration (if applicable), you have officially reserved your stall for this years Charter Fair, you will receive confirmation of your booking by return. You will be notified 2 weeks prior to the Fair of your pitch number.

Please note – Thrapston Charter Fair have the right to refuse permission for a stall/space at any stage. If permission is refused, a full refund will be given.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

SPACE

Stallholders must confine their stall to no more than 3m and pitch on the road between the markers on the kerb with your pitch number being the centre of your pitch and must provide their own tables, chairs, gazebo etc. We recommend you have a sturdy shelter as good weather cannot be relied upon and the Charter Fair will not be cancelled due to inclement weather. We do not provide electric.

ACCESS

You must access the High Street from Chancery Lane to register your arrival, you will be directed to your pitch, where unloading will be allowed. All vehicles must then be moved to the designated parking spaces and without exception, **NO vehicular access to the High Street or movement will be allowed after 12.45pm. EVERYONE MUST UNLOAD THEIR VEHICLE AND REMOVE THE VEHICLE BY 12.45PM**. For reasons of public safety, even if you decide to leave early, vehicular movement and access will not be permitted again until we open the road at 6pm (or before if the street it clear of pedestrians).

PROHIBITED ACTIVITIES

You may not provide, sell or offer as prizes any aerosol-powered 'silly string' or live animals (including fish), Ball Bearing Guns, Laser Pens and E-Cigarettes. Failure to adhere to this rule will result in the immediate closure of your stall and a ban from future events.

INSURANCE

As required by Northamptonshire County Council, your charity or business must have Public Liability Insurance with a minimum of £5 million cover.

RUBBISH

You will be responsible for removing any rubbish and ensure that your pitch is litter picked at the end of the day.
